- Athletes are encouraged to attend 3 free cheer clinics prior to tryout week.
- These clinics are held on Wednesdays: February 16th, 23rd and March 2nd from 4:00 5:00 pm.
- Athletes will learn basic cheer requirements including: jump technique, motion placement, basic tumbling skills and expression/voice while cheering. Coaches will be available to answer any candidate questions.

<u>ALL CANDIDATES</u> must have completed and turned in the <u>online application</u> by 4:00 pm on <u>Monday February 28th.</u> Applications will be posted on the Lufkin Cheer Website: http://lufkincheer.weebly.com/ following the mandatory parent/candidate meeting. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

- ➤ Mascot Candidates will meet on Monday, March 7th at the same time/location.
- > ALL candidates should wear the following to each clinic:
 - 1. T-shirt, shorts (with spankies underneath), and tennis shoes or cheer shoes.
 - 2. Hair should be secured, away from the face, in a ponytail.
 - 3. No jewelry of any kind may be worn.
 - 4. Cell phones will be turned in at the beginning of the clinic and passed back out at the end of the clinic.
- ➤ <u>These are closed clinics</u>. No one except the coaches and candidates may be present during this teaching time. Candidates may access the tryout material at the conclusion of the March 9th clinic via <u>www.lufkincheer.weebly.com</u>. Numbers for the order of tryouts will be drawn on Wednesday March 9th at the end of the clinic.



Lufkin ISD Cheerleading Tryouts

- ➤ LMS and LHS CHeer Tryouts for all teams will be held on **FRIDAY, MARCH 11, 2022** on the Lufkin High School campus. This is an early dismissal day and candidates must be present at school on March 11th to be eligible to tryout.
- ➤ There will not be special accommodations for injuries. No video tryouts will be allowed for unless pre-approved by the coaches and school administrators prior to the tryout clinic start date of March 7th.
- ➤ All cheer candidates will perform jumps, tumbling (optional), one cheer, and a one dance for the judges. Jumps, tumbling and the cheer portion will be performed individually. The dance will be performed in groups of 2-3, depending on tryout numbers.

All candidates will be required to wear the following:

- 1. Plain white t-shirt or tank top, solid purple shorts and tennis shoes.
- 2. Hair should be pulled back in a ponytail, with a white bow.
- 3. No jewelry of any kind may be worn.
- ➤ All Mascot candidates will perform one skit displaying a use of music, props and crowd involvement. Mascot skits should not exceed 3 minutes in total. Mascots are encouraged to use props.

On Tryout Day, the gold gym will be open for cheer candidates to warm up tumbling and jumps on the mats.

After check in, all candidates will be required to stay in the gold gym until their tryout time.

Phones will be collected at check in and returned following each athlete's final portion of the tryout.

➤ **ALL tryouts are closed**. Candidates should be released approximately 1- 1.5 hours after their tryout start time depending on the number of candidates for each squad. Judges may feel the need to have callbacks, in which they will request to see certain candidates again.

Lufkin Mascot Procedure for Selection

Tryout Process

- 1. Candidates are required to create one 2-4 minute skit for their tryout. Candidates will have access to the Panther Mascot Suit for this skit. The skit must include props and music.
 - **Mascot candidate music must be pre approved by the coach prior to tryouts.
- 2. All mascot candidates will also complete an short online survey answering the following questions: (a link to this survey will be provided to the candidate prior to the submission date)
 - a. How can you bring spirit to your school and community?
 - b. What is your definition of school spirit?
 - c. Why would you be a good mascot?
 - d. What can you do at the games to get the crowd more involved?

Procedure for Selection of Captain/Sr. Sargents

Candidates who meet the qualifications stated in the Lufkin Cheer Constitution are eligible to pick up the packet for selection of Cheer Captain and Sr. Sargent. These packets will be available at Cheer Tryouts (3/4/22) and are due MARCH 18th, 2022 at 4:00 pm. No late applications will be accepted.

Overview

The overall score of each candidates tryout will be combined with the following items to select the LHS Varsity Cheer Captain/Co-Captains and Sr. Sargent(s). These items will include: Google Slide Presentation (35 pts), Interview (25 pts), Original Cheer & Dance (25pts), Essay Prompt (15pts). Additionally a score will be given based on Merit/Demerit (20pts).

- -Judges (2) will score each candidate individual.
- -Each judges score will be added to create an overall score.
- -Each Judge will be using a rubric for guidance in scoring.
- -Merit/Demerit score will be added one time to the total score.
- -The maximum score a candidate could receive is 420 pts.
 - -Tryout 100pts x 3 Judges = 300 pts
- -Captain/Sr. Sargent Requirements = 100 pts
- -Merit/Demerit Score = 20 pts



Financial Information

Each cheerleader or mascot must assume the responsibility of expenses incurred from purchasing uniforms, attending cheerleader camp, and any additional miscellaneous expenses. These amounts are based on previous years expenses, and may vary. The total bill for the 2022-2023 school year may be less than the amount listed below. Returning members may recycle uniform pieces, spanks, rain jackets, etc from previous years to cut down on expenses. You may also purchase uniform pieces from a retired member.

Each selected cheerleader or mascot is responsible for the total balance. After uniform fittings, your individual bill will be sent via email to the parent or guardian.

Please note:

- 1) Scholarship funding may be up to, but not exceed, 50% of the total "Cheer Cost" bill. There is a limited amount of scholarship money, therefore the amount of scholarship money may vary by squad and by person. These are need-based scholarships only.
- 2) After tryouts, we will hold a raffle ticket fundraiser that will help offset out of pocket expenses for Lufkin ISD Cheer. Athletes will be able to use 100% of the money they raise to pay off their individual bill.
- 3) Please do not let the cost deter you or your athlete. We will find a way to make it work! There is ALWAYS a way! :)
